Our body has different parts. Each part has a name. Let us learn the names of our body parts.

We have five sense organs. Eye Ear Nose Tongue

Sense organs help us to sense and understand things around us.



Skin


NOSE

We have one nose. Nose helps us to smell different things. We also breathe through our nose.










TONGUE
